

New Club Membership Cards

Glenbrook residents that are in good standing and over the age of 14 are eligible to apply for a club membership card. Renters are required to present a utility bill with their name and Glenbrook address.

To apply, fill out the Membership Card Request Form below and send it along with your dues payment or drop it off at the club. Please include all birth dates of members <u>under</u> the age of 18. The homeowner must sign and date the bottom of the form. Membership cards are not made until you come to use the pool for the first time. Homeowners' accounts must have a zero balance before cards are issued.

You are required to show your membership cards every time you are use the pool so hook them to your pool bag.

If you should lose your card you will have to pay a \$2.00 replacement fee.

Brea Glenbrook follows the City Codes listed below regarding trash receptacles.

Brea City Code: 8.28.130 TIME AND DATE OF PLACEMENT OF RECEPTACLES.

A. No person shall place, or cause to be placed, any solid waste, green waste and/or recyclable receptacle therefor, in any public highway or in any place or in any manner other than herein-above provided, or at any time other than the days established by the city for the collection thereof on the particular route involved, earlier than sunset of the day preceding the day designated for collection, and all receptacles shall be removed from the place of collection prior to 10:00 p.m. of the day the receptacles have been emptied.

Brea City Code, Chapter 20.208: R-1 Single Family Residential Zone, Part E: Side Yards; Section 2c states the following

Brea City Code: Chapter 20.208: R-1 Single Family Residential Zone, Part E: Side Yards, Section2c states the following:

Any storage of materials including but not limited to, trash and trash receptacles, newspapers, building and automotive materials, landscape maintenance tools, and debris, within side yards, shall be substantially screened with a combination of open or solid fencing, and landscaping, or enclosed within an openwork structure such as wood or metal lattice, so as to substantially minimize views as seen from adjacent private and public streets, and public right-of-way (excluding alleys).

Architectural Control makes monthly inspections of all the homes in Brea Glenbrook and residences that are in violation of the City Codes will receive a letter.

Thank you in advance for following the rules for trash receptacles.
