## Glenbrook Community Meeting

The City of Brea and Lennar Homes (developer of the former Mercury site) met with more than 100 Glenbrook residents on Wednesday, January 14, to discuss potential traffic signal upgrades at the intersection of Associated Road and Greenbriar Lane, along with traffic-mitigation strategies to reduce cut-through traffic in the Glenbrook neighborhood. This meeting gave residents the opportunity to hear directly from decision-makers, ask questions, and provide feedback on proposed solutions impacting neighborhood safety.

Further discussion will take place at the City of Brea Traffic Commission meeting on Thursday, February 19, at 5:30 p.m. at the Brea Civic & Cultural Center, Executive Conference Room 1, located at Civic Center Circle. It is important for Glenbrook residents to attend this meeting to voice concerns and ask questions about potential changes that may affect our community.

To prepare for the Traffic Commission meeting, we will hold a Glenbrook community meeting on Tuesday, February 10, at 7:00 p.m. This meeting will allow residents to share concerns, develop questions, and formulate suggestions for possible solutions. Please plan to attend and email your discussion topics and recommendations to nfoxhall@breaglenbrook.org prior to February 10, 2026. We want to make sure everyone's voice is heard.

# **Things to Remember!!!**

## **1. Brea City Code:**

### **§ 8.28.130 TIME AND DATE OF PLACEMENT OF RECEP TACLES.**

A. No person shall place, or cause to be placed, any solid waste, green waste and/or recyclable receptacle therefor, in any public highway or in any place or in any manner other than herein-above provided, or at any time other than the days established by the city for the collection thereof on the particular route involved, earlier than sunset of the day preceding the day designated for collection, and all receptacles shall be removed from the place of collection prior to 10:00 p.m. of the day the receptacles have been emptied.

### **§ 20.208.040 PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS.**

#### **2. Side yards.**

c. Any storage of materials including but not limited to, trash and trash receptacles, newspapers, building and automotive materials, landscape maintenance tools, and debris, within side yards, shall be substantially screened with a combination of open or solid fencing, and landscaping, or enclosed within an openwork structure such as wood or metal lattice, so as to substantially minimize views as seen from adjacent private and public streets, and public right-of-way (excluding alleys).

## **2. Brea Glenbrook Architectural Guidelines and Maintenance Standards:**

### **TRASH CONTAINERS (Art. VI, S. 8)**

- a. All trash containers shall be stored behind gates so they are not visible from the street.
- b. Trash containers may be placed at the curb no earlier than 5 pm the day before trash pick-up and must be taken in the same day the trash is picked up.

3. Please pick up your dog waste, don't let your dog run on other residents' property, keep your dog tethered when they are out with you on your property so they don't run out when neighbors walk by and remember to keep them on a leash while you are out for a walk. Let's be courteous and mindful of our neighbors
