Pool is open weekends only starting in April 11th from 12pm-5:45pm. Fill out the membership application on page 3 and bring it with you when you come to use the pool. Applications will also be available at the club. We'll make your new cards while you swim. After the Memorial Day barbeque we'll be open daily so you can enjoy the pool every day of the week.

Swim lessons begin June 15th. We offer two week sessions starting June 15th through August 7th. Glenbrook residents have priority registration starting May 1st through May 17th. **You must come in and register and pay in full to be placed in a class.** Go to our website, www.breaglenbrookclub.com to see the swim lesson schedule. According to the city water conservation rules:

1. No outdoor watering from 10:00am – 4:00pm.
2. From October to **April**, the watering schedule is **one day a week**: Wednesday.
3. Limit watering to 10 minutes per station.

New Club Membership Cards

The pool is open weekends only starting April 11th. We will open daily starting May 26th. Make sure to get your new club membership cards. It's important to review the pool policies prior to coming to use the pool. Glenbrook residents that are in good standing and over the age of 14 are eligible to apply for a club membership card. Children ages 7-13 will be given junior membership cards. Their card will allow them on the pool deck but NOT allow them to bring guests. Renters are required to present a utility bill with their name and Glenbrook address.

To apply, fill out the Membership Card Request Form below and send it along with your dues payment or drop it off at the club.

Please include all birth dates of members under the age of 18. The homeowner must sign and date the bottom of the form.

Membership cards are not made until you come to use the pool for the first time. Homeowners' accounts must have a zero balance before cards are issued.

You are required to show your membership cards every time you use the pool so hook them to your pool bag.

If you should lose your card you will have to pay a \$2.00 replacement fee.

Things to Remember!!!

1. Brea City Code:

§ 8.28.130 TIME AND DATE OF PLACEMENT OF RECEPTACLES.

A. No person shall place, or cause to be placed, any solid waste, green waste and/or recyclable receptacle therefor, in any public highway or in any place or in any manner other than herein-above provided, or at any time other than the days established by the city for the collection thereof on the particular route involved, earlier than sunset of the day preceding the day designated for collection, and all receptacles shall be removed from the place of collection prior to 10:00 p.m. of the day the receptacles have been emptied.

§ 20.208.040 PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS.

2. Side yards.

c. Any storage of materials including but not limited to, trash and trash receptacles, newspapers, building and automotive materials, landscape maintenance tools, and debris, within side yards, shall be substantially screened with a combination of open or solid fencing, and landscaping, or enclosed within an openwork structure such as wood or metal lattice, so as to substantially minimize views as seen from adjacent private and public streets, and public right-of-way (excluding alleys).

2. Brea Glenbrook Architectural Guidelines and Maintenance Standards:

TRASH CONTAINERS (Art. VI, S. 8)

- a. All trash containers shall be stored behind gates so they are not visible from the street.
- b. Trash containers may be placed at the curb no earlier than 5 pm the day before trash pick-up and must be taken in the same day the trash is picked up.

3. Please pick up your dog waste, don't let your dog run on other residents' property, keep your dog tethered when they are out with you on your property so they don't run out when neighbors walk by and remember to keep them on a leash while you are out for a walk. Let's be courteous and mindful of our neighbors

4. Follow the Glenbrook rules for the club when you are on the club grounds. You can find the full list of rules on our website at www.breaglenbrookclub.com
